Mary Jane LANGSTON LOVE, Citizen of the Republic of Texas

Approved 26 January 2002 as Supplemental DRT Ancestor #23575-S

Mary Jane LANGSTON was born 10 May 1828. In Rusk County, Republic of Texas, on 27 March 1845, Mary Jane married David LOVE (1821-1892). They soon moved to Round Rock in Williamson County where their children were born: William Wesley (1847-1872), Sarah Texana (1849-1901), Clemmency Ann Levonia (1852-1910), Cecelia Ann V. (1854-1941), and Wesley (1856-1859).

Mary Jane died 31 August 1859, in Lampasas, Lampasas County, Texas, where she is buried in Old Cook Cemetery. Located in the NW corner of the small cemetery is an arch-shaped grave stone marked as follows: "Erected by D. Love; In memory of Mary J. Love who Died Aug. 31st 1859; Aged 31 years also Her Child 6 Mo."

August 17 2002, after the District V workshop in Lampasas, Sterling C. Robertson Chapter DRT, with much help from the people in Lampasas, held a dedication ceremony for the Citizen of Republic of Texas marker placed at Mary Jane's grave. (At the same time, we dedicated a marker at the Cook Cemetery grave of Rebecca Hughes, g-g-gm of another Sterling C. Robertson Chapter member, Nancy Franklin.)

David LOVE would return to Williamson County and marry Mary Susan CLUCK (1842-1905).

Mary Jane LANGSTON LOVE, David LOVE, and his parents, Wade and Jane WILSON LOVE, have been approved as Citizens of the Republic of Texas and as DRT Ancestors for Amelia Forrest Bogard.
